Judogis:

Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF, the competition system KO with quarterfinals (last 8) repechage on 3 mats.

- eliminatory rounds and repechage 3 mats (8 m x 8 m)
- fights for 3rd places 2 mats (8 m x 8 m)
- finals 1 mat (8 m x 8 m)


Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking List. Rest of the draw – separation by nations.

The blue and white judogis will be obligatory.

Judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule approved by IJF from the 1st January 2009.

All competitors are obliged to have back numbers on their judo:

- 1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
- **2.** The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
- **3.** The organizer will deliver the CHANGEABLE part during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.
